Finishing touches and afterthoughts



If you get all the cracks sealed and weather striped, all will be happy inside in the dead of winter.



For a while I just propped the lid open with an iron thing I had lying around.



But that got to be a nuisance so I put a support on a hinge so that it could be laid down when the lid is closed.



The hinge has to attach about 3 or 4 inches down from the top of the roof to allow the support to be long enough to hold the lid up high enough for good head clearance.



I had to add a couple blocks so the support wouldn't contact the plastic.



This is what it looks like in the down position. The lid would be closed over it.



Another afterthought was to stick in some shelves (that I also had lying around) for sprouting seeds.



Because heat rises, I ran the irrigation hose and wire for the light through one of the base sides.



I tried the thermometer several places. Right now it sits just below the lid and down near the front; just above the handle.....seems to be easiest to read here.

I think I about covered everything but if not, I guess you will discover what I left out along the way.
