

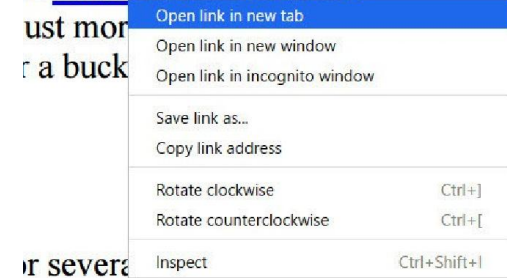
# Travel Advice 2

The time is never perfect

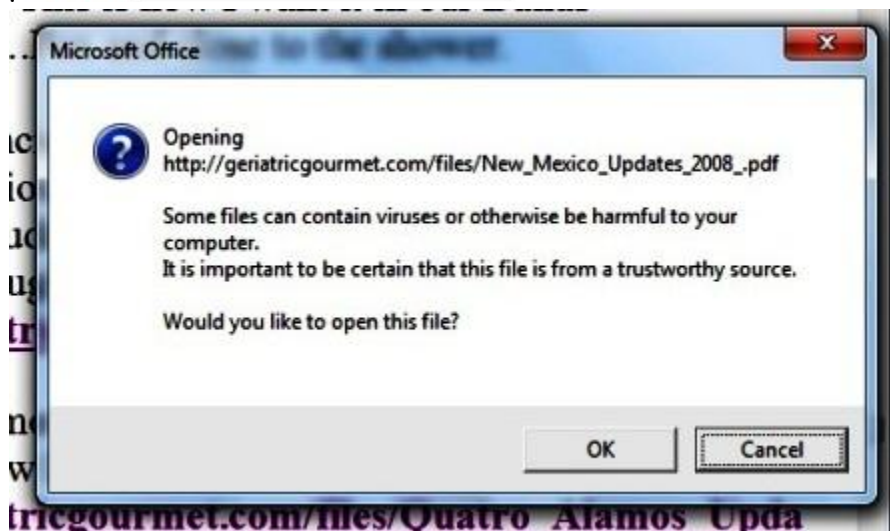
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You may get this warning but don't worry. It won't cause a flat tire on your car or your toilet to be stopped up. And they're mostly [just nonsense anyway](#).
